Developer Dajia is renovating the 1931 landmark with interiors designed by Jean-Louis Deniot and an art collection curated by art collector and auctioneer Simon de Pury.</i></p>
11:30am – 12:15pm	<p>Study tour</p> <p><i>V: Central Park Tower, 225 West 57th Street, New York, NY 10019</i></p> <p><i>Central Park Tower, designed by Adrian Smith + Gordon Gill Architecture in the Midtown Manhattan, is the tallest residential tower ever realized (1,550 feet/472 m). It was developed by Extell Development Company and Shanghai Municipal Investment Group.</i></p>
12:30pm – 01:30pm	<p>Study tour</p> <p><i>V: Time Warner Center, 10 Columbus Cir, New York, NY 10019</i></p> <p><i>Time Warner Center is an iconic indoor destination attracting more than 16 million visitors annually. Located in the heart of Manhattan at Columbus Circle the Time Warner Center is officially renamed as Deutsch Bank Center after the German Multinational investment bank became the “anchor tenant” in the beginning of 2021. It contains two 750-foot (230 m) twin towers, connected by a multi-story atrium. The building has a total floor area of 2.8 million square feet (260,000 m²). It contains office space, residential condominiums, the Mandarin Oriental, New York hotel, and the Jazz at Lincoln Center entertainment venue as well as a shopping mall.</i></p>
